NEW YORK AREA

#### Day 1 – Wed May 27 – Depart USA

Your pilgrimage begins as you depart the USA on an overnight flight

#### Day 2 – Thu May 28 – Arrive Tel-Aviv

You will be welcomed at the Tel Aviv airport by our representative and transferred to your hotel to enjoy dinner before retiring for the night.

#### Day 3 – Fri May 29 – The Galilee

Worship as you sail across the Sea of Galilee. Visit Capernaum, center of Jesus' ministry in the Galilee, and visit the synagogue built on the site where Jesus taught (Matt. 4:13, 23). On the Mount of Beatitudes, contemplate the "Sermon on the Mount" (Matt. 5-7). Explore the Church of the Fish and the Loaves at Tabgha, traditional site of the feeding of the 5,000 (Luke 9:10). See the Chapel of the Primacy, where Peter professed his devotion three times to the risen Christ (John 21). In Magdala, once home to Mary Magdalene, visit a recently discovered first-century synagogue.

#### Day 4 – Sat May 30 – Cana, Nazareth, Megiddo & Caesarea

Begin today in Nazareth, Jesus' boyhood home (Matthew 2:23). Look out over Tel Megiddo (Armageddon) to view one of the most important archaeological sites in Israel. Today's last stop is Caesarea, a center of the early Christians where an angel visited Cornelius, the first Gentile believer (Acts 10), and where Paul was imprisoned for two years before appealing to Caesar.

#### Day 5 – Sun May 31 – Qasr El Yehud, Jericho & Mount of Olives

Visit the baptismal site of Qasr el Yehud, where tradition says Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist. Travel to Jericho (the oldest city in the world) and visit the ruins of the ancient city conquered by Joshua (Josh. 6:1, 2 & 20). In the distance, you can see the traditional site of the Temptation of Jesus (Matt. 4:1-11). Stand atop the Mount of Olives as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem, including the Temple Mount and Dome of the Rock. Forty days after his resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven from the Mount of Olives (Acts 1: 9 - 12).

#### Day 6 – Mon Jun 1 – Masada, Qumran & the Dead Sea

Enjoy a visit to intriguing Masada, the spectacular mountaintop fortress built by Herod that later became the final tragic stronghold of the Jewish rebellion against the Romans. Ride the cable car to the top to explore the fortress and look down upon the remains of the Roman camps and siege ramp below. Continue to Qumran, site of the Dead Sea Scroll discovery. End your day with the opportunity to take a dip in the mineral laden waters of the Dead Sea.

#### Day 7 – Tue Jun 2 – Jerusalem & Bethlehem

In Bethlehem, visit the cave revered as Jesus' birthplace and see the Church of the Nativity constructed over the site (Matt. 1: 18 -25). Gaze out over Shepherds Field before you returning to Jerusalem. Pray in the Garden of Gethsemane and envision the scenes of the night before Jesus' crucifixion (Matt. 26: 36 - 44). Continue to Mount Zion to visit the House of the High Priest Caiaphas, where Jesus was questioned the night of His betrayal (Matt. 26: 57). Meditate on the events of the Last Supper as you visit the traditional location of the Upper Room (Mark 14: 12).

#### Day 8 – Wed Jun 3 – Jerusalem & the Old City

Walk the Cardo, the ancient main street of the Old City. Explore ancient Jerusalem at the Teaching Steps and the Western Wall. View the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle (John 5: 1-31). Sing a hymn in the Church of St. Anne and

experience its rich acoustics. Visit Herod's Antonia Fortress, where Jesus appeared before Pontius Pilate (Luke 23:1), and follow in Christ's steps on the Via Dolorosa ("the Way of the Cross"). At the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, take time to reflect on His sacrificial love.

**Day 9 – Thu Jun 4 – Jerusalem**

Travel to Ein Karem, birthplace of John the Baptist and where Mary visited Elisabeth (Luke 1: 26 -40). Explore the poignant exhibits of Yad Vashem, Israel's Holocaust Memorial. Visit the Garden Tomb for a time of reflection and communion.

The selling price is based on double occupancy and a minimum of **30** persons traveling throughout. Single rooms are available for an additional **\$648.00**. If the tour totals are less than **30** people, the selling price could increase depending on the final number of the group, and it will be the responsibility of the host to inform their people about this increase. Also, if the tour totals are less than **10** full paying persons, EOT may not be able to secure group rates from the airlines and hotels and would have to combine the group with another tour or cancel the tour.

**Host Benefits: One Earned Tour for every Five Full Paying Persons.** This benefit is predicated on a minimum of **30** people, and may be modified if there are less than **30** traveling.

**Early Deposits:**

Registrations received prior to 10 months from departure date (**Jul 27, 2019**) can register with a **\$100.00** deposit. An additional deposit of **\$500.00** is due 6 months prior to the departure date (**Nov 27, 2019**)

Registrations received before 6 months plus one day (**Nov 26, 2019**) can register with a **\$300.00** deposit. An additional deposit of **\$300.00** is due 6 months prior to the departure date (**Nov 27, 2019**)

**Deposits:**

Those registering less than 6 months (**November 28, 2019**) to 106 days prior (**February 11, 2020**) will need to pay the full **\$600.00** deposit. No registration will be processed without a deposit.

**Second Deposit** (required for those booking airfare through EO):

A second deposit of **\$1,200.00** is required 105 days prior to departure (**February 12, 2020**). Airfare will not be processed without this second deposit. (Note: Ground Only Guests are not required to pay the second deposit at 105 days)

**Final Payment:**

Final payment is due 75 days prior to departure (**March 13, 2020**). If payment is not received by this date, there will be an automatic \$100.00 late fee assessed.

**Travel Protection Plan:**

The Travel Protection Plan premium is due by the second deposit date of 105 days prior to departure (**February 12, 2020**). This amount must be paid in addition to the deposits.

**Late Registrations:**

Registrations received after the second deposit date are welcome, but please note the below late registration schedule:

Registrations received 104 days (**February 13, 2020**) to 90 days prior (**February 27, 2020**) will incur a late fee of \$100.00.

Registrations received 89 days prior (**February 28, 2020**) to 75 days prior (**March 13, 2020**) will incur a late fee of \$200.00.

Registrations received 74 days prior (**March 14, 2020**) to 60 days prior (**March 28, 2020**) will incur a late fee of \$400.00.

Registrations received 59 days (**March 29, 2020**) or closer to departure will incur additional air and land fees based on availability and cost. Additional fees will be advised prior to processing the registration.

**Passports** must be valid for 6 months after the return date (**December 5, 2020**).

**Dietary & Seating** requests must be submitted in writing and are not guaranteed.

**Final Documents** are sent out 2 – 4 weeks prior to departure.

**Cancellation Policy:**

100% of Cancellation Fees are covered by the optional Travel Protection Program provided premium has been paid and reason for cancellation is insurable. Those who do not take travel protection should be aware of the following cancellation penalties:

From day of registration to 105 days prior to departure, you will be charged the \$100 non-refundable administrative fee plus any airline fees.

Additionally, thereafter, you will be charged any airline penalties and a single room supplement if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single plus the following charges:

104-60 days = \$400;

59-45 days = \$600;

44-31 days= 40% of total cost;

30 days to day of departure = 100% of total cost.

Cancellation must be submitted in writing. On or after day of departure, no refund will be paid for any services not used.

**Fit To Travel Statement:** People registering for the tour accept the responsibility for being in good health and able to walk and travel on the tour.
